Emergency Assistance

The Bishop's Annual Appeal provides significant funding to Catholic Charities in order to ensure that the Emergency Assistance program continues to provide services to those in need throughout Eastern North

Carolina. One great example of this occurred in Perquimans County when a house fire significantly impacted a family of four.

While nobody was injured in the tragedy, the family was left with no home or possessions, as everything was destroyed. The family was referred to Catholic Charities, where a case manager was able to provide financial assistance so the

family could purchase food, clothing, furniture and household items. Now, thanks to the help of the BAA, this family has a sense of hope that they will be able to rebuild their lives after such a tragic event.



Blessings in a Backpack

This past fall, two ministries supported by the Bishop's Annual Appeal, Catholic Schools and Catholic Charities, joined forces to provide students, within the Diocese, with much needed school supplies. Educators throughout the Diocese, as well as students from Cardinal Gibbons High School, collected 324 backpacks, each filled with school supplies, in a drive called "Blessings in a Backpack." Catholic Charities distributed the backpacks to students throughout our Diocese. Lisa Perkins, Assistant Director of Catholic Charities said, "Children want to learn; they want to fit in with their peers. This kind gesture will allow them to do so with dignity and respect." This act of generosity is yet another example of how funds raised through the Bishop's Annual Appeal provide vital services to our neighbors in need.

Asistencia en Emergencia

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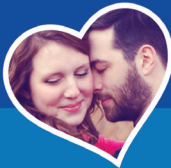
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
