Parish Council Meeting
Monday, September 25

Various items of importance for all our parishioners were discussed.

The *Día de la Independencia* of the Hispanic Community, celebrated on Friday, September 15, in the Sampson County Civic Center, had a net profit of \$26, 093.95. A portion of this money will be used for a much-needed storage building, which will be located directly behind the Father Price Center.

The design submitted by Fred Schoenleber and Fran Leerkes will measure 32'X 24', and will include a separate space for the storage of all chairs and tables currently in the Price Center. Fred will supervise the construction of the building, which will occur on a Saturday in the near future, pending the approval of the Finance Council.

Another project that has emerged is the redesign and redrawing of our parking lot between the church and the Father Price Center. Benefactors have offered to pay for the cement work needed to properly finish what has become an exit to the side nearest to the church. The idea is that the traffic would be "one way" with an entrance to the farther side. The spaces would be angled to facilitate entering and leaving the space, as well as encouraging the "one directional" layout. This Project also is pending the review and approval of the Finance Council.

Finally, it was determined that a Sunday date in April after Easter and before First Communion is the most desirable time for the Spring Festival in 2018. A Festival Committee will be established in the near future. Georgina Zeng and José Baños will serve as co-chairpersons of the committee. This year the Spring Festival netted \$8,629.31 for the parish.

Reunión del Consejo Parroquial
Lunes, 25 de septiembre

Algunos temas de interés a la feligresía fueron discutidos.

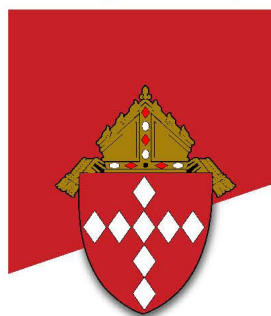
El *Día de la Independencia* de la comunidad hispana, celebrado el viernes, 15 de septiembre, en el Sampson County Civic Center, tuvo ganancias de \$26, 093.95. Parte de este dinero será destinado a construir un almacén, el cual será ubicado detrás del Centro Father Price.

El diseño del almacén, sometido por el carpintero Fred Schoenleber y el ingeniero Fran Leerkes, tendrá dimensiones de 32'X 24' e incluirá un espacio sólo para mesas y sillas. Fred será supervisor del proyecto, contando con la cooperación de la comunidad hispana, uno de estos sábados en un porvenir próximo. El proyecto espera la aprobación del Consejo de Finanzas.

Otro proyecto discutido fue el diseño y configuración del estacionamiento entre la iglesia y el Centro. Bienhechores han ofrecido a costear la construcción de una salida en cemento con este provisto: qué el tráfico fluyera en dirección única con la entrada al lado derecho (más cerca del Centro) y la salida al lado izquierdo (más cerca de la iglesia). Este proyecto, también, espera la aprobación del Consejo de Finanzas.

Por último, se decidió a buscar una fecha en abril después del Domingo de Pascua (pero antes de la Primera Comunión) para el Festival de Primavera 2018. Un Comité del Festival será establecido en un futuro próximo. Georgina Zeng y José Baños encabezarán el Comité (y serán los encargados del Festival). En este año el Festival tuvo ganancias de \$8,629.31 para la parroquia.

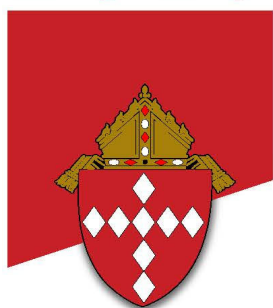

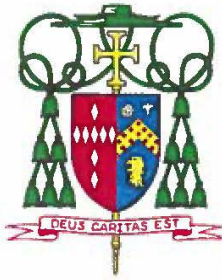

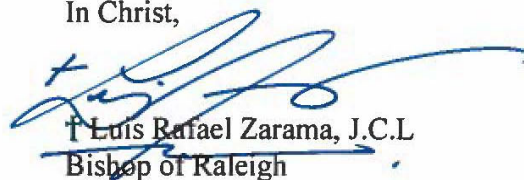
Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

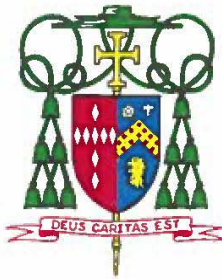

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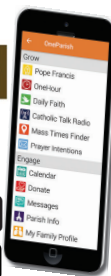
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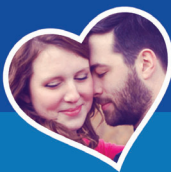
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
